

2017 JIAA ARTS FESTIVAL
Festival Sales Tent Entry Requirements
March 10, 11, 12, 2017

New Sale Item Check-In:

Tuesday, March 7 and Wednesday March 8

9:00 AM – 4:00 PM
at the Festival Sales Tent across from Goodyear Cottage

Any member of the Jekyll Island Arts Association is eligible to sell their non-judged artwork through the Festival Sales Tent at the Arts Festival. **All members selling items must volunteer at least 2 hours of service during the festival.** Volunteer sign up sheets will be available during registration.

There will be one large shop at the Art Festival in 2017, not two shops as there have been in the past. All items will be for sale in a large 40' by 10' weatherproof tent with security provided across from the entrance to Goodyear Cottage. All items presently for sale in the Goodyear Shop will be automatically transferred to the Festival Sales Tent. If you do not want your items transferred to the outside Festival Sales Tent, please remove your items from the Goodyear Sales Shop by Thursday, March 2 between the hours of 12 Noon and 4:00 PM. If not removed by that date, they will be transferred to the Festival Sales Tent. If you still want to remove your items after that deadline, you may do so at the tent March 7 and 8 from 9:00 AM until 4:00 PM.

If you wish to bring new items to sell in the Festival Sales Tent that are not presently in the Goodyear Shop, please fill out a new blue **Shop Entry Form**.

Shop Entry Forms will be available at Goodyear Cottage and available to print from the JIAA website beginning February 1. Completed Shop Entry Forms must accompany all sales items that are checked in for sale in the Festival Sales Tent.

New items for sale may be checked in with their completed Shop Entry Form on **March 7 and 8 from 9:00 AM until 4:00 PM** at the Festival Sales Tent, which will be located across from the entrance to Goodyear Cottage.

GENERAL CRITERIA FOR CONSIGNMENT SALES

1. All items must be original artwork made by the seller, prints of seller's original artwork, or items hand-made by the seller.
2. No items less than \$5.00 will be accepted.
3. Quantity and size of items accepted are dependent on the available space in the shop.
4. All unframed prints in bins in salesroom must be wrapped in clear plastic.
5. All work must be clean, undamaged, and ready for display.
6. All work must be labeled by the seller with member number, item number, and price. Items that are the same should have the same item number and be recorded on one line of the consignment form.
7. Wall art must be ready to hang, with wire attached. (**No saw tooth hangers.**)
8. No unframed canvases unless sides are finished and have no staples

showing.

9. No wet paint or varnish.

PRICING FOR CONSIGNMENT

1. Pricing is the responsibility of the seller. Pricing is before tax.
2. **25% commission will be collected on items sold** and 75% paid to the seller.

LIABILITY

All work is entered at the artist's risk. JIAA cannot assume responsibility for loss or damage during the Festival, although due care will be taken in handling all work.

UNSOLD ITEMS

The artist or their representative must pick up all unsold items for sale in the Festival Sales Tent on Sunday, March 13 between 4:00 – 6:00 PM or between **9:00 - 12:00** noon Monday, March 14. No sales items will go back in the Goodyear Shop until they begin accepting Sales Shop items again on April 1, 2016. Any items that have not picked up by 12:00 noon on Monday, March 13 will become the property of the JIAA and will be donated to various Jekyll Island organizations for their fundraising efforts.
